

NRA: national regulatory authority



Energy law in the EEA Agreement – Internal energy market

- 3rd Energy Package
 - Framework for the internal energy market
 - In force since October 2019
- Network codes
 - Operational and technical rules
 - In force since 31 July 2021



CACM: capacity allocation and congestion management

EB: Electricity balancing SO: system operation

FCA: forward capacity allocation

ESA role in energy: Two Hats

Surveillance

- Core task ESA: conformity assessments, complaints
- Are the EEA EFTA States transposing in time and correctly?
- Mirroring the role of the Commission in the EU


Regulatory


- ☐ Taking binding supervisory decisions instead of the EC or the EU agency (ACER)
- ☐ Issuing **opinion** on correct implementation (e.g. certification of Statnett, carbon capture and storage draft permits)

Close cooperation with national regulatory authorities (NRAs), EC, ACFR and Governments

Opinions and recommendations


- Non-binding




General cooperation – ESA and ACER

 - Economic Area (EEA)
 - □Regular interactions ACER ESA throughout the process
 - □ESA decisions addressed to EEA EFTA NRAs and national implementation by EEA EFTA NRAs
